# **Introducing our CSA Farm**

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a relationship between our farm and you as our customer. Rather than simply purchasing food, our customers become "members" of this CSA farm who receive a portion of the farm's harvest.

Our CSA runs for 18 weeks from June to October. Members are responsible for showing up at the agreed upon pick up site each week to receive your share of harvested produce.

#### Sharing in the risk of crop failure

We promise to do our best to provide you with a bountiful share each week. The quantity of produce however may vary from week to week due to extreme weather, insects or other production factors despite our best efforts. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share the risk of crop failure with us and other members. In the unlikely event of a crop failure, we compensate for that crop by filing your share with other crops grown on our farm that are ready for harvest at that time as best we can.

### Picking up your weekly basket

You are responsible for observing our drop site rules, which are as follows:

Pick up your share within the timeframe stated. Although we deliver high-quality produce to the site, it will decline quickly if not picked up in time. Please return last week's box every week, we recycle.

If you cannot pick up your share, you must arrange for someone else to pick it up for you. You are responsible for explaining the pickup location and procedures to your substitute. If you wish to change your drop site, you must give us minimum one weeks' notice. Shares that are not retrieved within the pick-up time will be sold at the market or donated to charity (Pelham Cares).

### Member fees

By selling membership in advance of the growing season, CSA reduces the burden of up-front costs for the farmer. Your membership fees provide us with money to purchase seed and equipment before the season starts, and we appreciate your commitment.
